City Clerk To Review Changes To the Agenda

Raymond Compari, City Administrator, advised there are Resolutions of Support for two new cannabis applicants on the agenda this evening and reminded everyone that they rescinded five at the last meeting, therefore the two on the agenda will not exceed the 21 limit and there are currently 16 Resolutions of Support and the two this evening will bring us to 18.

Mr. Compari further reviewed the cannabis licensing process.

There being no further comments Vice-Mayor Sooy declared the public comment portion closed.

Discussion of Commissioners

Commissioner Hewitt reported on the past citywide activities and expressed his appreciation to Commissioner Romanik for inviting the public safety employees to the picnic that was held at the Ukrainian Church.

Vice-Mayor Sooy reported that there are several garages and apartments at the New Jersey Motorsports Park and advised that some of the inspections were not conducted properly due to the apartments being misnumbered which caused some problems in the Tax Office and advised the Construction Department has been getting everything up-to-date and once that is complete it will be submitted to the Tax Assessor to ensure the proper taxes are being collected and anticipates that to be resolved soon.

Vice-Mayor Sooy declared the public comment portion open and asked if any person present wished to be heard. There being no response, Vice-Mayor Sooy declared the public comment portion closed.
