Dear Citizens,

Please be advised that the City of Millville passed an Ordinance #44-2023 on December 5, 2023, to create a Solid Waste Utility.

This was necessary due to State Statute (NJSA 40:66 – 1.3) that requires municipalities to reimburse housing complexes for their trash collection when trash is included in the municipal tax rate. The costs required by the City to provide this service would have an astronomical effect on the City of Millville budget and on future year's tax rate.

After careful review of our options, it was decided that the most economical and cost-effective solution for our residents is to create a Solid Waste Utility. Fees to support this Utility will be set by resolution of the governing body every year.

The yet-to-be-determined fee will be calculated by taking the total cost anticipated for trash disposal and divided by the number of residents serviced. This amount will be billed to our residential units and due on a quarterly basis.

There will be one bill sent out in January every year, which will contain 4 quarterly stubs and due on Feb 1, May 1, August 1, and Nov 1.
